

# WEEKLY MARKET REPORT

29th May-2nd June 2023

#### MARKET COMMENTARY

#### **Equity Market**

- During the week, NMB emerged as the best-performing stock, reaching a new 52-week high of TZS 3,640 per share. This represents a weekly increase of 4.6% and a year-to-date growth of 21%.
- The bank has set a dividend payment of TZS 286 per share for 2022, offering a yield of 7.9% to
  its investors. Swiss also experienced a positive performance, closing the week with a 2.7% gain.
- However, several counters recorded losses for the week, including DCB (-2.7%), CRDB (-8%), and Tanga Cement (-9.4%).
- On a broader scale, the All-Share Index concluded the week in positive territory, rising by 22.8
  points due to the strong performance of cross-listed stocks. Conversely, the Tanzania Share
  Index declined by 13.23 points, indicating a relatively disappointing performance of domestic
  stocks.

#### FIXED INCOME SECURITIES AND THE MACROECONOMIC LANDSCAPE

- The ongoing trend of increasing yields in the government bond market persisted after the Wednesday auction for the 10-year treasury bond. The yield experienced a significant rise of 17.2 basis points, reaching 11.22%.
- In its April monthly report, the Bank of Tanzania announced a decrease in inflation to 4.3%.
   Additionally, credit extended to the private sector witnessed robust growth of 22.5%.
- The overall lending rates stood averaged 15.91%, while deposit rates averaged 6.79%. In the Interbank Cash Market, interest rates ranged between 4.88% and 4.92%.


